BOARD RESOLUTIONS

At the Special Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Near West Intergenerational School on September 27, 2021 following resolutions was proposed and approved by the board:

WHEREAS: A student brought a pocket knife to school, which according to Board policy on Bringing Weapons to School, is Level 4 (highest in severity) of the Behavioral Code Violations and warrants expulsion for one year.

WHEREAS: This Board policy also allows "with concurrence of the Board of Directors, may reduce this requirement on a case-by-case basis in accordance with State Laws"

WHEREAS: School and Model Leadership are in agreement and do NOT recommend expulsion for this particular student and see an out-of-school suspension with added social/emotional supports to be a more appropriate course of action.
