I have been **EXPOSED** to someone who has COVID-19

I am UNVACCINATED or NOT up-to-date with my vaccines

If you are unvaccinated OR only received one does of Pfizer or Moderna

OR

If you completed the primary series* of Pfizer or Moderna more than six months ago and NOT boosted.

OR

If you have completed the primary series* of Johnson & Johnson vaccine more than two months ago and NOT boosted



- Alert the school to your exposure and vaccination status.
- Stay home for five days after your last exposure, then wear a mask around others at all times
- If you develop symptoms test and STAY HOME until you receive your results.
- If you test positive, alert the school and STAY HOME until you are fever free for 24 hours and symptoms are improving.
- The school will notify families in the positive student's homeroom & math class

A primary series of two does of Moderna or Pfizer vaccine or one does of Johnson & Johnson vaccine OR three does of Pfizer or Moderna if you received an additional does because you are immunocompromised

I have been **EXPOSED** to someone who has COVID-19

My COVID-19 Vaccines ARE up-to-date

If you received a booster dose of ANY COVID-19 vaccine

OR

If you completed the primary series* of Pfizer or Moderna less than six months ago.

OR

If you have completed the primary series* of Johnson & Johnson vaccine less than two months ago.



- Alert the school to your exposure and vaccination status.
- Wear a mask around others for ten days
- If you develop symptoms test and STAY HOME until you receive your results.
- If you test positive, alert the school and STAY HOME until you are fever free for 24 hours and symptoms are improving.
- The school will notify families in the positive student's homeroom & math class

I am **experiencing** COVID-19 symptoms with no known exposure. What do I do?

Regardless of Vaccination Status



- ALERT THE SCHOOL to your symptoms.
- STAY HOME regardless of vaccinations status
- TEST for COVID-19
- STAY AWAY from other people as much as possible, including others in your household.



If you are symptomatic

DO

- STAY HOME until you receive your test results, are fever free for 24 hours AND other symptoms improve
- Wear a mask for the next five days.



DO NOT

- Resume normal activities with a mask

If you are having symptoms of COVID-19 and waiting for your test results, STAY HOME until you get your results.

I have tested **POSITIVE** for COVID-19. What do I do?

Regardless of Symptoms or Vaccination Status



- ALERT THE SCHOOL to your test results
- STAY HOME for the next five days regardless of symptoms or vaccinations status
- STAY AWAY from other people as much as possible, including others in your household.
- THE SCHOOL will notifying families in the positive student's homeroom & math class



If you have a fever or other symptoms that haven't gotten better on day six

DO

- STAY HOME until you are fever free for 24 hours AND other symptoms improve
- Wear a mask for the next five days.

DO NOT

- Resume normal activities with a mask



If you are having symptoms of COVID-19 and waiting for your test results, STAY HOME until you get your results.
