I was **EXPOSED** to COVID. What do I do?

Regardless of Vaccination Status

- ALERT THE SCHOOL to your exposure.
- WEAR A MASK IN ALL PUBLIC PLACES for the next TEN DAYS
- TEST for COVID-19 for on DAY SIX
- STAY AWAY from other people as much as possible, including others in your household.

If you test **NEGATIVE** on day 6

DO

- Continue to wear a mask until DAY TEN



If you test **POSITIVE** on day 6

DO

- ALERT the school of your **POSITIVE** diagnosis
- **STAY HOME** for **5 FULL days**.
- If you are fever & symptom free for 5 days you may return to school **MASKED** for an additional 5 days.

If you test positive for COVID-19 at ANY time, notify the school immediately

I have tested **POSITIVE** for COVID-19. What do I do?

Regardless of Symptoms or Vaccination Status



- ALERT THE SCHOOL to your test results
- STAY HOME for the next **FIVE DAYS** regardless of symptoms or vaccinations status
- STAY AWAY from other people as much as possible, including others in your household.
- THE SCHOOL will notifying families in the positive student's homeroom & math class

If you have a fever or other symptoms that haven't gotten better on day six

DO

- STAY HOME until you are fever free for 24 hours AND other symptoms improve
- Wear a mask from DAY 6 to DAY 10.

DO NOT

- Resume normal activities without a mask



I am **experiencing** cold-like symptoms with no known exposure. What do I do?

Regardless of Vaccination Status



- ALERT THE SCHOOL to your symptoms.
- WEAR A MASK TO SCHOOL while symptomatic
- TEST for COVID-19 for 3-5 consecutive days
- STAY AWAY from other people as much as possible, including others in your household.



If you are symptomatic

DO

- MASK until you are symptom free OR have tested negative for COVID-19, on 3-5 consecutive days

DO NOT

- Resume normal activities without a mask.



If you test positive for COVID-19 at ANY time, notify the school immediately

How do I count my isolation days when COVID **POSITIVE**?

Positive with NO Symptoms

- DAY 0 = the day you were tested
- DAY 1 = First full day **following** the day you are tested
- If you develop symptoms, the clock restarts at Day 0 on the day of symptom onset
- You can end isolation **after** day 5 if you are fever & symptom free
- Continue to wear a mask from day 6 to day 10.

Positive WITH Symptoms

- Day 0 = the day of symptom onset
- 1 = the first FULL day after the day your symptoms started
- You can end isolation **after** day 5 if you are fever & symptom free
- Continue to wear a mask from day 6 to day 10.

What does 'up to date on vaccinations' mean?

- You are 5-17 and have received a Pfizer primary series AND Pfizer **booster 5 months** after initial series.
- You are 5-17 and have received a Moderna primary series

- You are 18-49 and have received a Pfizer primary series AND Pfizer booster **5 months** after initial series
- You are 18-49 and have received a Moderna primary series AND Moderna booster **5 months** after initial series
- You are 18-19 and have received a J & J primary AND Pfizer or Moderna booster **2 months** after initial shot .

- You are 50 + and have received a Pfizer primary series, a booster **5 months** after initial series PLUS a 2nd booster four months after 1st booster.
- You are 50 + and have received a Moderna primary series, a booster **5 months** after initial series PLUS a 2nd booster four months after 1st booster.
- You are 50 + and have received a J & J primary AND Pfizer or Moderna booster **2 months** after initial shot PLUS a 2nd booster four months after 1st booster. .
